



## **SWECET position regarding Remote Learning**

The Trust recognises that there will be a range of approaches in relation to the delivery of Remote Learning that take account of the educational phase, individual needs of pupils and the respective infrastructure and resources available.

The following principles will apply across all SWECET schools:

- Provision is available to an individual or group of pupils from the first day of an approved Covid-19 absence.
- It will provide curriculum continuity and enables pupils to continue their learning.
- The offer will be a blend of high quality online and offline resources as appropriate.
- We will ensure there is some opportunity for the pupil/s to have teacher interaction, feedback and assessment.
- Individual schools will work directly with the families of SEND children unable to access remote education without adult support to ensure their access to a broad and ambitious curriculum.
- Pupils without online access will be provided with alternative resources to support curriculum continuity.

Schools will use a range of different platforms, resources and software as part of a suite of online and offline provision.
