### Measuring the impact of the careers programme on pupils

The Careers Education team aim to provide an up-to-date and comprehensive service of information and guidance to the students, parents/carers and to colleagues and therefore undertakes a range of activities (listed below) to quality assure the provision.

- Learner evaluations after they have had interviews with a career guidance practitioner.
- The September Guarantee which tracks and monitors post 16 destinations and retention.

- Surveying colleagues to see how many are incorporating information on careers into subject lessons and subject display materials.
- Survey feedback from external providers and participants in careers related events and activities
- Compass+ reviews – half-termly
